



SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Blue Moon Gallery is a project of the nonprofit Southern Aroostook Cultural Arts Project (SACAP). The Blue Moon Gallery is dedicated to providing opportunities to the southern Aroostook community to experience art in many forms by inviting artists or groups of artists to show their work to the public. Historically, Blue Moon Gallery exhibits have been by invitation, and have often involved collaboration with a community organization or guild. Several exhibits have included an occasion for public discussion of the art.

There are a few opportunities each year for “artist-inspired “ exhibits, and the Blue Moon Gallery is now accepting proposals from artists for exhibits for the year 2009. A proposed exhibit can be of an individual artists’ work or a group of artists can collaborate to produce an exhibit.

Applications will be accepted or not based on quality of artwork, interest or relevance of the exhibit idea to the community.

Eligibility

Entries are reviewed on a rolling basis.

Artists working in any medium are invited to submit 12-20 images of current, original work for review on CD or a DVD of video artwork. Recommended resolution for 4”x6” images is 600 dpi in JPEG file format only. CD’s should contain only the image files; all other supporting information, such as a resume, must be mailed with the entry form. Applicants are encouraged to include a contact sheet of the JPEG images.

Artists must be 18 years or older. To be considered, applications must include:

- 12-20 images* of current work for review and/or work to be exhibited
- Completed application form
- Resume or biography or artist’s statement
- Optional: Synopsis of a proposed lecture, demonstration and/or workshop (with estimated running time), if planning to offer such activities.

**All CDs and/or DVDs must be clearly labeled with the artist’s name and images.*

Sales

If the artist is not a member of Visions (SACAP’s retail space), commissioned sales can be arranged through Visions. The commission on non-member sales is 40%. Work must remain in the gallery until the end of the exhibition.

Exhibition Policies

Reproduction Rights: The Blue Moon Gallery and the Southern Aroostook Cultural Arts Project reserves the right to reproduce any work accepted for exhibition for publicity, marketing and/or documentation. The Blue Moon Gallery and the Southern Aroostook Cultural Arts Project also assume the right to photograph works for publicity or catalogue purposes.

The Blue Moon Gallery reserves the right to reject works that have been inaccurately represented by the example provided or deemed inappropriate for exhibit at this venue. The Blue Moon Gallery reserves the right to reject works for exhibition that are not original, are deemed extraordinarily fragile or unstable, or are not installation ready. Works must be received ready for installation: work must be framed, matted wired, etc. All media is welcome, however, video production artists must provide their own TV, DVD player, etc., during the show. The artist is responsible for costs to deliver and/or ship artwork, and for insurance during shipment and exhibition. SACAP will exercise the same care for the borrowed items as it does in the safekeeping of comparable property on the premises.
